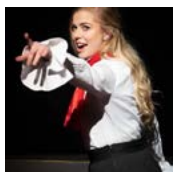
About the Production Team

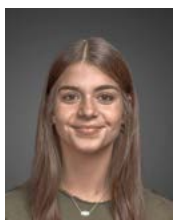
About the Cast
